




BED BUG FECAL STAINS (LOOKS LIKE AN INK SMEAR)

#### Caulk




- 1. Clean and dr the area.
- 2. Remove the cap and cut the tip at a 45 angle.
- 3. Squee e the caulk into cracks and crevices.
- 4. Smooth it with a nishing tool.
- 5. Remove e cess with a damp sponge before it dries.


